## Spring/Summer Home Care Tips

Inspect ceramic tile countertops; re-seal grout as needed
☐ Inspect exterior paint, stain or siding, putty and caulking
☐ Inspect plumbing fixtures for signs of leakage
☐ Inspect shower and tub caulking; re-caulk as needed
☐ Lubricate door hinges with silicone spray
☐ Lubricate rollers and guides on garage door and opener
☐ Flush all yard drains and trim grass around inlets
☐ Check for ground settlement around foundation and fill where necessary
☐ Check that your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors are powered – we suggest to change your batteries annually/as needed
☐ Check the foundation and
☐ Clean aerators on faucets and shower heads
☐ Prune shrubbery and add mulch to perennial flower beds
☐ Change direction ceiling fan rotation so air is blowing down during the warm moths of the year
☐ Adjust sprinkler settings for new season
☐ HVAC system check
<ul> <li>We recommend having an HVAC professional do a routine-check before the heat starts rising</li> </ul>
☐ Vacuum return and/or supply air vents if they are dirty
<ul> <li>Replace the furnace filter. Make future replacements as needed or directed by the manufacturer</li> </ul>
Reprogram your thermostat settings for Spring/Summer
☐ If your thermostat uses batteries, now may be the time to replace them
Fireplace maintenance
☐ Have the chimney inspected and cleaned
<ul> <li>Make sure to keep the damper closed and airtight to keep conditioned air from escaping your home</li> </ul>
☐ Since you won't be using it in this weather, close the gas line
☐ Check the roof
☐ Replace loose shingles
<ul> <li>Make sure the flashing around the chimney or vent pipes is watertight</li> </ul>
$\square$ Check the bricks and mortar and repair mortar if missing
$\square$ Clean gutters and point downspout away from the house
☐ Trim any tree limbs that are hanging over or touching the roof
